STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS

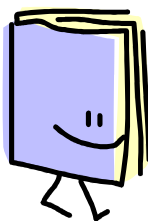

OUTSTANDING ACCOUNTS

With the end of our financial year approaching, we urgently require settlement of all outstanding accounts. Students' Leaving Certificate and Record of Achievements may be held pending account payment. Subject Fees are charged for all subjects that include a "take home" component, or for which

materials are supplied by the school. Any unpaid Subject Fees may affect students' 2009 options. The School Contribution is used to assist a huge number of student activities through funding equipment and services that are not paid for by the Ministry of Education. This includes the School Nurse, new technology, sports gear, activities like the Duke of Edinburgh Scheme, Records of Achievement, subsidizing the School Magazine and technical support for all of the information technology our students use.
