END OF YEAR CLEARANCE

Year 11, 12 and 13 students have been issued with a clearance form and are required to complete it by Friday 4th November. This will identify all the text books and any outstanding payments, such as Subject Fees, that are required before students can be cleared for the year.

Text books must be returned to the Subject Teacher for checking during a scheduled class, and may be re-issued for use during examination revision if they are required. Reissued textbooks are to be returned to the Kerikeri High School Library.

The completed clearance forms must be handed in by Form Time on Friday 4th November. Student documentation may be delayed if this clearance is not fully completed. We ask for your cooperation.
