### GATEWAY PROGRAMME

Gateway is an exciting programme at Kerikeri High School. Over 75 senior students have taken advantage of the Gateway programme this year and have been placed with local businesses.

The Gateway programme is for students to experience what it is like working in the industry they have chosen. This usually entails a six week minimum placement, working one day a week. Many of our students participate for a term, and some up to three terms. Students are required to achieve on average ten credits in either school or outside provider assessments that relate to the industry they are involved in. The students must also catch up on the work missed while at the placement, so it has quite a heavy commitment.

The success of the placements is dependent on the willingness of both the business owners and the students – the programme could not happen without this.
