

## **Year 13 Dress Code**

We expect that as Year 13 students you present yourself in a neat, clean and tidy fashion and that you take pride in your appearance. Kerikeri High School is your place of work and as such you are reminded that the appropriate dress code must be worn at school. Boys are required to wear a collared shirt.

Items not permitted include:

- jandals, scuffs, slippers, work boots or work socks
- beachwear (including board-shorts)
- ripped denim or clothing
- collarless t-shirts
- beanies or knitted hats.
- facial piercings
- bare midriffs, visible bra straps or bare shoulders
- any clothing with large advertisements logos or seen to be promoting inappropriate things such as gangs, alcohol, tobacco or drugs.
- skimpy clothing is also not appropriate; any shorts or skirts must be of a suitable length comparable to the school uniform; sports shorts, eg rugby shorts are not acceptable.
- tights may not be worn without a suitable length top or skirt over them.

### **OSH Regulations**

Footwear must meet OSH regulations and be safe for you to wear around school and in the classroom. Extreme high heels and footwear without back straps may present a safety risk. Students must have their feet sufficiently covered in Science Laboratories and Technology areas; including Hospitality and Automotive.
