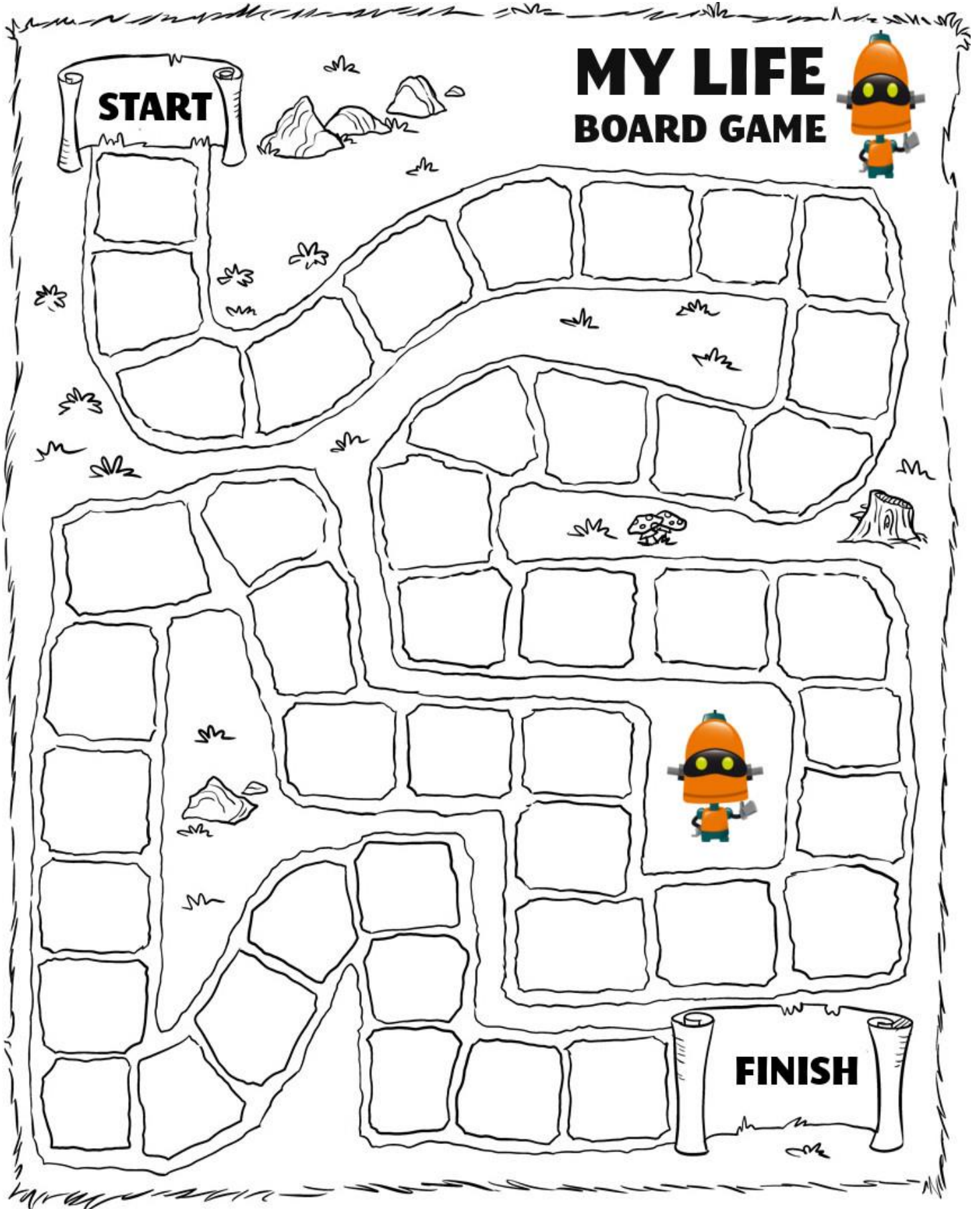

## ANZAC DAY – Recipe to try at home

Anzac biscuits have long been associated with the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps (ANZAC).

It has been claimed that biscuits were sent by wives and women's groups to soldiers abroad because the ingredients do not spoil easily, and the biscuits kept well during naval transportation

Use the recipe below to make your own ANZAC Biscuits. Please make sure you get an adult to help and then use the space below to put in a picture of your creations.

### Ingredients

- 125 grams (4oz) butter, chopped
- 2 tablespoons golden syrup or treacle  
(see tips)
- 1/2 teaspoon bicarbonate of soda (baking soda)
- 2 tablespoons boiling water
- 1 cup (90g) rolled oats (see tips)
- 1 cup (150g) plain (all-purpose) flour
- 1 cup (220g) firmly packed brown sugar
- 3/4 cup (60g) desiccated coconut

### Method

- 1** Preheat oven to 180°C/350°F.  
Grease two large oven trays; line with baking paper.
- 2** Stir butter and syrup in a medium saucepan over low heat until smooth. Stir in combined soda and the water, then remaining ingredients.
- 3** Roll level tablespoons of mixture into balls; place 5cm (2in) apart on lined trays, then flatten slightly.
- 4** Bake for 12 minutes or until golden.  
Cool biscuits on trays.
