**Over 16,000 New Zealanders died in World War one, with the Gallipoli campaign being responsible for 2,779 of those deaths. This was big for New Zealand, as at the time, the country only had a population of one million. New Zealand also supplied horses for WW1, out of the 10,000 horses sent to war, only 4 returned home.**
