IMPORTANT MESSAGES

The battle of Passchendaele took place between the 31st of June and the 6th of November. Capturing Passchendaele would mean that the allies would have an upper hand against the German forces. An attack planned by British and Australian troops on the 9th of October was done to open a way for the second ANZAC corps to capture Passchendaele on the 12th of October. The plan failed, causing heavy casualties. 843 New Zealanders were either dead or lying mortally wounded in the front lines.
